

Walton Amateur Regatta 1908, showing the large crowds on the Mount Felix/Hillrise finish area.



From 1894 the focus of the regatta had moved downstream from Mount Pleasant to Sir Arthur Sullivan's River House. A military band was engaged to provide music (including Sullivan's own). Sir Arthur often had with him his collaborator, Dr. W.S. Gilbert, and Richard D'Oyly Carte, who owned the Savoy Hotel, staged operas at his Savoy

Theatre and who had recently built himself an island house at Weybridge, even now still very familiar to rowers from all the local clubs.

Walton Town Regatta, 10th August 1910.



The first Walton Town Regatta is believed to have taken place in 1887. Held in late August it was open to local watermen and others not eligible for Walton Amateur Regatta (founded 1862).

In 1910 the Surrey Herald reported that: "Glorious weather and a long and interesting programme resulted in this

year's Town Regatta ... proving the most enjoyable riverside festival that Walton has seen for many years."

The picture above was taken outside Rosewell's Lower Boathouse, next to the Anglers, and the skiffs and punts shown here could be hired for 1/- (5p) per hour for the first hour and 6d ($2\frac{1}{2}$ p) for each subsequent hour.

The Town Regatta lapsed after the Second World War. The reduction in the number of people working on the river and relaxation of the Amateur Rowing Association rules on amateur status removed the need for a separate regatta.

An advertisement for Rosewells Boathouse in the Walton Town Guide dates from the late 1890's.



The Boathouse café and boat hire now operates from the right hand side of the building.

It was in this building on 18th September 1927 that a meeting was held which decided to form Walton Rowing Club.

Robert Moore

Robert Moore, President of the Regatta from 2007 to 2019 died in February this year.

He first joined the organising committee in 1985, later becoming Chairman. Over the years, his responsibilities on the day included Judge, Commentator and presenting prizes to the winners


Robert was a key member of Walton Rowing Club but could also be found timing, aligning or providing the commentary at rowing events from inter-club races to Henley Royal Regatta and the World Championships.



57) Women's Junior 14 Double Sculls (Band 1) Sponsored by Weybridge Rowing Club







RACING TIMETABLE Explanation of coding in the 'event' column

J13, J14, J15, J16 and J18 indicate age the age of competitors (WJ indicates female competitors). A 'Master' is anyone over 27 years!

Competitors now gain points from processional races ('Heads') and regattas depending on how well they do. These points are added together for a crew to form a 'Crew Ranking Index' (CRI). The idea is to race similarly ranked crews in the same 'band' for more competitive racing. The familiar terms such as 'novice' are therefore no longer used.

1 is a one person boat; 2 is two people, 4 is four and 8 is eight.

'x' indicates sculling. A figure without the x indicates a rowing event (also known as sweep oar). '+' indicates a coxed boat. Thus Open 4+ indicates a coxed Four event.

How to read the timetable

Each race has a unique number and can be a heat or a final. Winners of a heat go through to the next round or final at the time indicated above.


Each competitor has a race number worn on the bow rower's back; they retain this number throughout the event regardless of the number of heats. E.G. number 64 remains constant through the competition.
